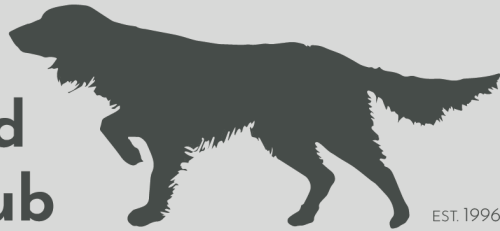


German Longhaired Pointer Club



GLPC Judging Criteria

List B (Breed Specialists)

Judges whom the German Longhaired Pointer Club would support to judge the breed.

- 1) To have 5 years' experience owning and exhibiting in this breed and have the support of the German Longhaired Pointer Club.
- 2) To have judged 20 dogs of this breed with a good geographical spread.
- 3) To have attended at least one breed specific judging seminar and passed an assessment where applicable.

List B (Non-Breed Specialists)

Judges whom the German Longhaired Pointer Club would support to judge the breed.

- 1) To have 7 years judging experience in any one breed and have the support of the German Longhaired Pointer Club.
- 2) To have judged 20 dogs of this breed with a good geographical spread.
- 3) To have attended at least one breed specific judging seminar and passed an assessment where applicable.

List C (Breed Specialists)

For aspirant judges within the breed who have the support of the German Longhaired Pointer Club.

List C (Non-Breed Specialists)

For aspirant judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the German Longhaired Pointer Club.

Judges lists are compiled by the German Longhaired Pointer Club Committee giving due cognizance to: -

- a) Number of years over which judging experience is spread.
- b) Number of dogs actually judged, as opposed to number of entries received
- c) General judging experience in breeds other than German Longhaired Pointers
- d) KC mandatory assessments attended/passed
- e) German Longhaired Pointer Seminars attended
- f) Stewarding engagements undertaken
